The church council at its January 11th meeting was unanimous in its motion to thank you for the excellent workmanship, and your dedication in getting the job done in a very professional manner.

We also very much appreciate your generous gift of the additional rank, the Great 8 foot Unda Maris, as a memorial to Fritz Minnick, Phil's brother.

Each Sunday members tell us how great they think the organ sounds. Others comment about how beautiful the exposed pipes are with a more symmetrical look.

I, as organist, appreciate the six new ranks, more depth in the bass pedals, more possibilities of different sounds, and a better blended voicing. The old harsh sound is gone and a mellower vital blend is apparent. I am still enjoying experimenting with different combinations of stops. The trumpet rank is exciting and one stop we've always wanted to have added.

Our day of dedication, January 10, 1988 was truly a mile-stone in the life of our congregation. The morning service, with Ron Kenriech as organist and the Otterbein Brass Quartet was inspiring. The noon congregational dinner was a "Feast Celebration". Dr. William Haller's afternoon recital was a glorious display of our organ's tonal possibilities.

Your skill and expertise, along with our congregation's generous giving, have made it possible for us to praise the Lord in glorious sounds.
