The Bunn-Minnick Organ Company of Columbus, Ohio has recently rebuilt and enlarged the W. W. Kimball Organ in this Church. Within the course of their work they releathered all parts of the instrument requiring such work, cleaned and repaired existing pipework in the instrument (dating from 1896) and added twelve (12) additional ranks to the instrument.
